

Dear Manhattan Students, Parents and Guardians:

This afternoon Governor Bullock extended the **School Closure to April 10th** and **mandated social distancing**. Manhattan Public School will continue online instruction and curriculum packet materials pickup. Starting tomorrow **ALL** of the exterior doors to the school buildings will be locked. The front/vestibule doors will be open from 8:00 am - 12:00 noon, Monday - Friday. Teachers will facilitate and leave items for student/parent pick up/exchange in the entrance vestibule from 8:00 am - 12:00 noon. Parents can schedule alternate times to pick up items in the vestibule by contacting the offices.

The Manhattan School Community continues to meet the challenge of the school closure. The feedback we have received is positive. However, in some cases, parents and students are beginning to feel the burden of staying at home, working from home and guiding their children through instruction. Please reach out to your children's teachers and communicate how it is going and if adjustments are needed.
