Thank you for coming to pick up your child from school. We truly appreciate your contribution to keeping Manhattan School District and the community of Manhattan safe and healthy. We hope to see your child healthy and back in school as soon as possible!

___ **COVID-19 Related Major Symptoms.** Student has at least ONE of the following symptoms: cough (new, unexplained, or severe), shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, difficulty breathing.

Requirements to return to school:

- 1) Test negative for COVID-19 and be fever free for 24hrs and symptom improvement
- 2) Test positive for COVID-19 and meet CDC/GCCHD requirements for ending isolation
- 3) 10 days since symptoms began and fever free for 24hrs and symptom improvement

___ **COVID-19 Related Minor Symptoms.** Student has at least TWO of the following symptoms: temperature >100.4F, chills, muscle aches, sore throat, headache, runny nose or congestion, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or fatigue.

Requirements to return to school: Same as above for Major Symptoms

___ **Fever.** Student has a fever >100.4F using a digital temporal thermometer. Keep your child home for 24 hours **after** his/her temperature returns to normal without the use of fever reducing medications.

___ **Vomiting.** Keep your child home for 24 hours after the last episode of vomiting. (48 hours if diagnosed with norovirus).

___ **Diarrhea.** Keep your child home for 24 hours after the last episode of diarrhea. (48 hours if diagnosed with norovirus).

___ **Unexplained Rash.** Keep your child home until the rash is gone or you obtain a medical note from their physician stating that the rash is not contagious or they start on prescribed medications for the rash (can return 24hrs after the medication was started).

___ **Conjunctivitis** (pink eye). Redness, itching, and discharge from one or both eyes. Keep your child home until they are symptom free or on medication for conjunctivitis for 24hrs.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- If your child is tested for COVID-19, **STAY HOME** until a test result is obtained.
- Please stay in communication with the school so that we know when to expect your child back at school. PLEASE ALSO PROVIDE A COPY OF TEST RESULTS TO THE SCHOOL NURSE.
- If your child is asked to **quarantine** due to being a close contact, please stay home for 14 days following exposure. This information will be relayed to you by the Gallatin City County Health Department.
- It is the responsibility of the student to follow current **building level homework/make up policies** during their absence. However, in the event of a quarantine the student will be able to access remote learning, which will be initiated by the student's teacher(s).
- Take care of your child, help them get **rest, stay hydrated, cover coughs, and wash hands.**
- Call 911 or call ahead to the Emergency Department if you or your child experience trouble breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion, the inability to wake or stay awake, or bluish lips or face.
