MANHATTAN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Guidelines:

The Manhattan Volunteer Fire Department has chosen to sponsor a scholarship to be awarded to a Manhattan High School Senior who is interested in going into the emergency response profession or have any family members who have or are currently serving as emergency response personnel. Emergency personnel include firefighter, EMT and paramedic, nurse, police, etc. The Scholarship to be awarded will be in the amount of \$250, to be used for the discretion of awardee towards further education.

Criteria:

- Applicant is a graduating senior the year the scholarship is granted
- Applicant has a cumulative GPA 2.0 (provide proof)
- Applicant attends Manhattan High School
- Applicant has interest in pursuing a job in Emergency Personnel

OR

Applicant has a family member who is involved in the Emergency System

General Information and Application Process

To apply for the MVFD Scholarship students need to submit an essay describing where in the emergency field the applicant is interested, and why they are choosing that direction of profession.

OR

The applicant's essay needs to reflect the experience of having a family member involved in the emergency system and what that meant to the applicant. The applicant might have had an experience that changed their view or life because of a family member(s) being an emergency personnel.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS MAY 15th OF THE GRADUATING YEAR

Applicants must submit; application with essay attached, and proof of GPA. All applications need to be submitted to the school counselor and will be further reviewed by a scholarship committee. The school counselor will notify MVFD President of scholarship awardee. Awardee will receive scholarship money within 30 days of graduation.
