

Symptoms Requiring Student Pick-Up

Next Steps

Thank you for coming to pick up your child from school. We truly appreciate your contribution to keeping Manhattan School District and the community of Manhattan safe and healthy. We hope to see your child healthy and back in school as soon as possible!

Follow these important steps to identify the level of response necessary.

1. Initial Steps

Choose ONE of the following options, and please make sure to describe all symptoms and when they developed.

- a. Contact your child's Pediatrician's (or family Physician's) office.

- b. Contact or visit your local Urgent Care.

- c. Contact the Bozeman Health COVID-19 Hotline
 - i. M-F 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. | Wknds 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - ii. (406) 414-2619
- d. Visit a Bozeman Health Viral Triage Clinic
 - i. Bozeman Health Deaconess Hospital, Entrance 4 | M-F 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. | Sat from 8 a.m. to noon.
 - ii. Bozeman Health Belgrade Clinic | M-F 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. | Wknds 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

2. IF a COVID-19 test is recommended

Proceed to a Drive-Thru COVID-19 Test Site. Your physician will provide the order to the testing site and this must be obtained prior to testing.

- a. There are currently three Drive-Thru Test Sites:
 - i. Bozeman Health Deaconess Hospital (Lot H)
 1. Hours: M-F, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - ii. Bozeman Health Belgrade Clinic + UrgentCare
 1. Hours: M-F, 8a.m. to 7p.m. | Wknds 8a.m. to 5p.m.

3. STAY HOME

- a. UNTIL a test result is obtained, OR further direction is received by your physician
- b. Take care of yourself, get rest, stay hydrated, cover your coughs, and wash your hands.

- c. Monitor your symptoms and follow instructions from your healthcare provider and local health department.
- d. Call 911 or call ahead to the Emergency Department if you experience trouble breathing, persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion, the inability to wake or stay awake, or bluish lips or face.

4. Return Guidelines

- a. As a reminder, stay home until test results are obtained. Please stay in communication with the school so that we know when to expect your child back at school. PLEASE ALSO PROVIDE A COPY OF TEST RESULTS TO THE SCHOOL NURSE.
- b. If your physician evaluates your child's symptoms and determines that a COVID-19 test is not necessary, please provide documentation that your child may return to school.
- c. If results indicate a positive test for COVID-19 your child may return to school 10 days after the initial onset of symptoms AND relief of a fever without fever reducing medication for 24 hours AND an improvement in overall symptoms.
- d. If results indicate a negative test for COVID-19 your child may return to school when he/she is fever free for at least 24 hours.
- e. If you choose not to get a COVID-19 test your child may return to school 10 days after the initial onset of symptoms and no symptoms within the last 24 hours.

5. Quarantine

If your child is asked to **quarantine** please stay home for 14 days following exposure. This information will be determined on a case-by-case basis and a positive COVID-19 test in a close contact, and relayed to you by the Gallatin County Health Department.

6. Academic expectations

It is the responsibility of the student to follow current building level homework/make up policies during their absence. However, in the event of a quarantine the student will be able to access remote learning, which will be initiated by the student's teacher(s).
